Due diligence includes thoroughly reading a company's literature and its Franchise Disclosure Document, calling and visiting existing franchisees, and consulting with an attorney and an accountant. Electric vehicle company Fisker's stock plunged more than 40% in after-hours trading on Wednesday as investor concern about the company's ability to stay in business intensified.

On Wednesday, the Wall Street Journal, citing people familiar with the matter, reported that Fisker had hired restructuring advisers to work on a potential bankruptcy filing.

Fisker declined to comment on the report, but earlier this month, the EV maker warned that it might not have enough money to survive another year.

In its fourth-quarter earnings report, released in February, the company said there was "substantial doubt about Fisker's ability to continue as a going concern."

At the time, Fisker said it was in discussion with an existing investor about possibly putting more money into the company to keep it afloat. The automaker said it would also lay off 15% of its workforce to cut costs.
